FATHER AS A SHOPPER



Another role of the father is noted as that of a shopper. The positioning of fathers as shopper is highly significant within the family mainly because:

Secondly This segment is time pressed they have less time to stimulate within the family and especially children hence buying stuff for children is seen as a very easy and approachable method of communicating emotions. (love, care, happiness)

Thirdly Fathers also believe that because of their intrinsic personality weakness they are not much expressive (as females) hence purchasing products are seen as a channel to show love and care.

Fourthly Children expect certain eating /playing items like burgers, confectionery, ice cream etc when fathers

arrive home from work. Hence they don't want to disappoint them.

Fathers want to communicate their love, happiness, care & enjoyment to their children through products. They want them to get recognized, avoid inferiority complex within children & get accepted under normal circumstances
